



Patient Notice of the Sunshine Act & Open Payments

The federal Physician Payments Sunshine Act requires that detailed information about payment and other payments of value worth over ten dollars (\$10.00) from manufacturers of drugs, medical devices, and biologic products to physicians and teaching hospitals be made available to the general public.

This data is published annually in a database known as Open Payments. The Open Payments database is a federal program used to search payments made by drug, device, and biological companies to physicians and teaching hospitals.
