- Show respect to teachers, volunteers, parents, and other students through words, actions, and attitude.
- Participate willingly in classes and activities, listen to instruction, and avoid behavior that distracts from learning.
- Follow directions promptly, remain in approved areas, and stay with adult supervision.
- Respect the church building, classrooms, materials, equipment, and the belongings of others.
- Use computers, internet access, and personal electronic devices only as permitted and only for appropriate educational purposes.
- Do not access inappropriate material, misuse technology, harass others, or interfere with devices, software, or internet systems.
- Practice kindness, honesty, self-control, and encouragement toward others, seeking to resolve disagreements respectfully.
- Help maintain a safe environment by following check-in procedures, parking lot and outdoor supervision rules, and all staff instructions.
- Come prepared to learn, arrive on time whenever possible, and do your best to contribute positively to the co-op community.
- Understand that repeated or serious misconduct may result in loss of privileges, parent contact, suspension, or removal from the co-op as determined by staff and the board.
