

WINDOW REPLACEMENT

REQUIREMENTS FOR WINDOW REPLACEMENT



Elevation Plan

- Provide an elevation plan showing what windows will be replaced by location and window count.



Window Specifications

- Windows must match the existing windows with the same grid locations and dimensions.
- Frame color: White.
- Glass type: Clear or slightly smoky.
- No colored or reflective glass or tint allowed.
- Frame at the exterior must be caulked.
- A building permit is required unless a written exemption from the Department of Planning and Permitting (DPP) is provided.



Samples

- Provide a sample window frame and glass.



Installation

- Frame at the exterior must be caulked.
- Wood trim must be painted to match the building.

Additional Notes:

- Ensure all documentation is submitted for review and approval prior to commencing any replacement work.
- Compliance with these guidelines is essential to maintain the aesthetic and structural integrity of the property.
