Origins of the Pasque Flower

Habitat

Sandy, sunny pastures in Central and Northern Europe. Blooms in early spring and again in autumn.



Folklore

Historically used to color Easter eggs. Legends say fairies sheltered inside the petals to protect themselves from the elements.



Properties

Contains Anemonin, an active principle that is highly acrid in its fresh state but neutralized when dried.



The Four Golden Keynotes

Changeable & Erratic

Symptoms constantly shift. Pains wander rapidly from joint to joint; moods fluctuate unpredictably.



Thirstless

Complete lack of thirst with almost all complaints, even during fevers, due to a dread of internal fullness.

Chilly but Craves Open Air

The patient feels cold but is suffocated by warm, stuffy rooms. Relief comes from crisp, cool air.



Thick, Bland Discharges

Mucus from the eyes, ears, or nose is characteristically thick, yellowish-green, and non-irritating to the skin.

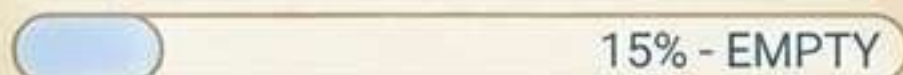

Desires:

Disgust for warm fats, pork, and rich pastries.



Digestive Reaction
Eating rich, fatty foods leads to slow digestion, waterbrash, and a sensation of a stone in the stomach. Infants may hiccup after eating.

Upper Body Afflictions

Head

One-sided, pulsating headaches. Feels as if the brain would burst and eyes fall out. Worse in the evening; better walking in open air.

Eyes

Conjunctivitis with thick yellow-green discharge. Recurring styes on upper lids. Eyelids stick together at night. Better from cold bathing.

Ears

Severe throbbing earaches, worse at night in warm beds. Sensation of something crawling or pushing outward. Excellent for swimmer's ear.

The Respiratory Cycle

Night



Dry, tickly, severe cough. Sensation of the throat closing off or suffocating in a warm room. Forced to sit up in bed for relief.

Morning



Cough becomes wet and loose upon waking. Copious expectoration of thick, yellowish matter.

Asthma or shortness of breath triggered by environmental sensitivities, always improved by breathing cold outside air.

The Hormonal Lifespan

Puberty

Never well since puberty. Delayed first menses in mild, gentle girls. Acne in young girls.



Pregnancy

Morning sickness, heartburn, and bluish varicose veins that worsen toward evening. Threat of false labor pains.



Menstruation

Irregular, late, or scanty flow. Blood is dark and clotted. Severe weeping, facial swelling, and silent peevishness before the period.



Menopause

Hot flashes accompanied by a tendency to faint in warm rooms. Weepy and morose moods.

Joints and Urinary Tract



Urinary Tract

Recurrent bladder infections with a sudden, urgent need to urinate. Involuntary urination at night (bedwetting), or when coughing, laughing, and passing flatus.



Joints & Extremities

Rapidly shifting joint pains. Joints become swollen, red, and hot. Pains worsen from letting the limb hang down and hot applications; greatly relieved by cold compresses.

Acute Care Applications

Measles & Mumps

Used as a prophylactic for measles. Treats mumps, especially when the infection metastasizes.

Ear Infections

The #1 remedy for children waking in the night crying with pulsating ear pain, begging to be held.

Digestive Upset

Indigestion, bloating, and nausea specifically following the consumption of rich pork or ice cream.

Eye Infections

Blocked tear ducts in infants and acute conjunctivitis where cold air brings relief.

Colds & Flu

Upper respiratory infections marked by copious, bland nasal discharge and a total loss of taste and smell.

Allium Cepa

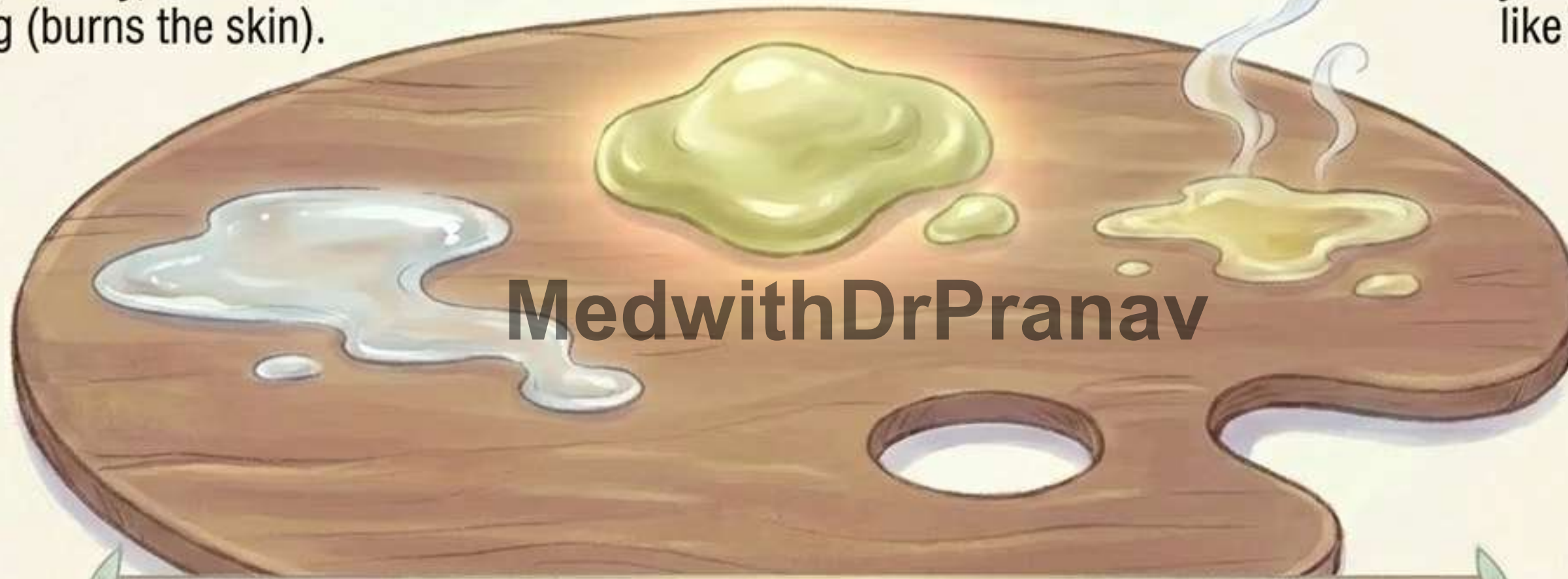
Thin, watery, and
excoriating (burns the skin).

Pulsatilla

Bland (non-irritating),
copious, and thick.

Arsenicum

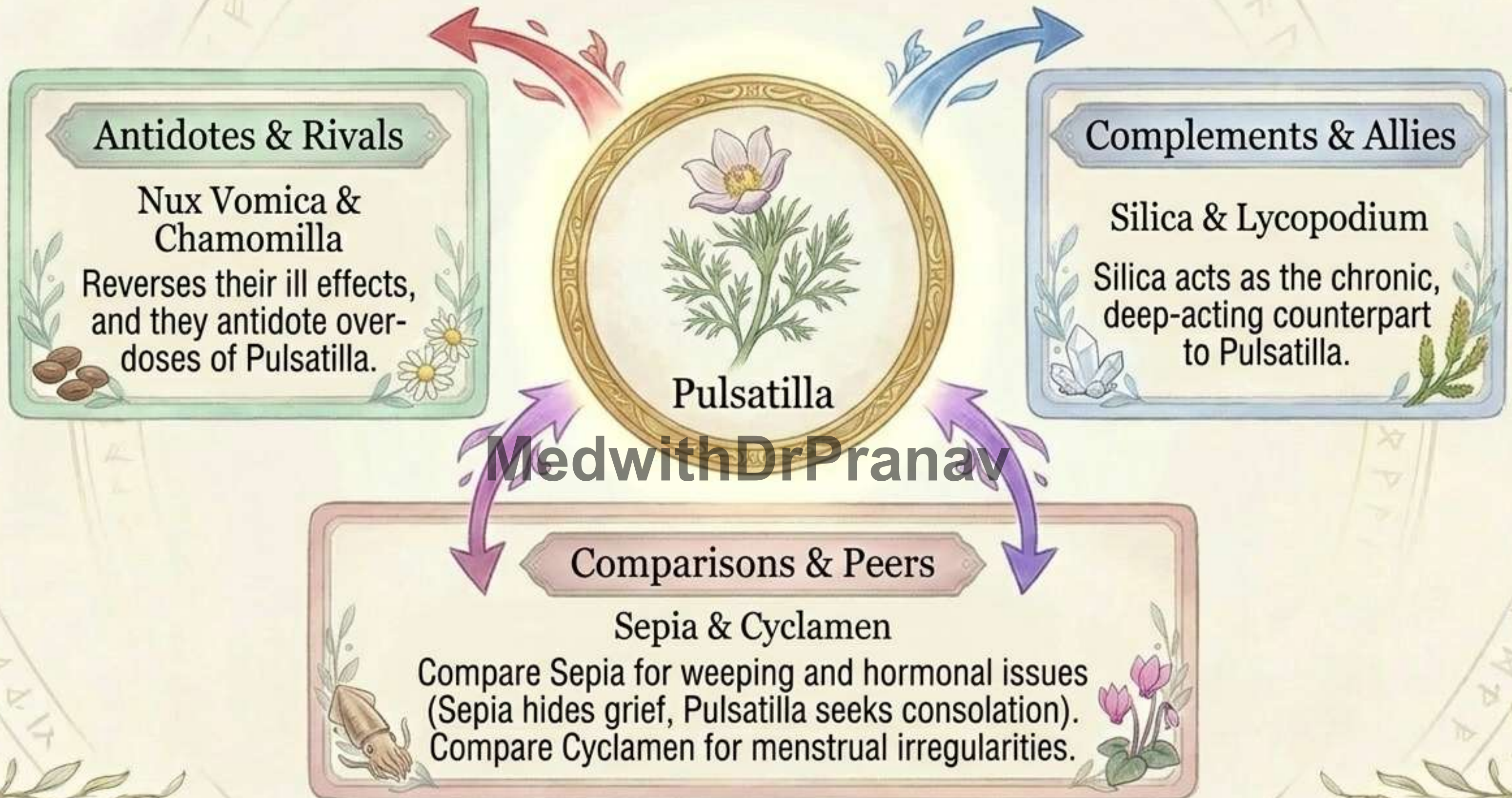
Scanty and burning
like fire.

A key diagnostic indicator: No matter where the discharge originates (eyes, ears, nose, or vagina), the Windflower's secretions are almost always thick, green-yellow, and completely bland.

Remedy Relationship Network

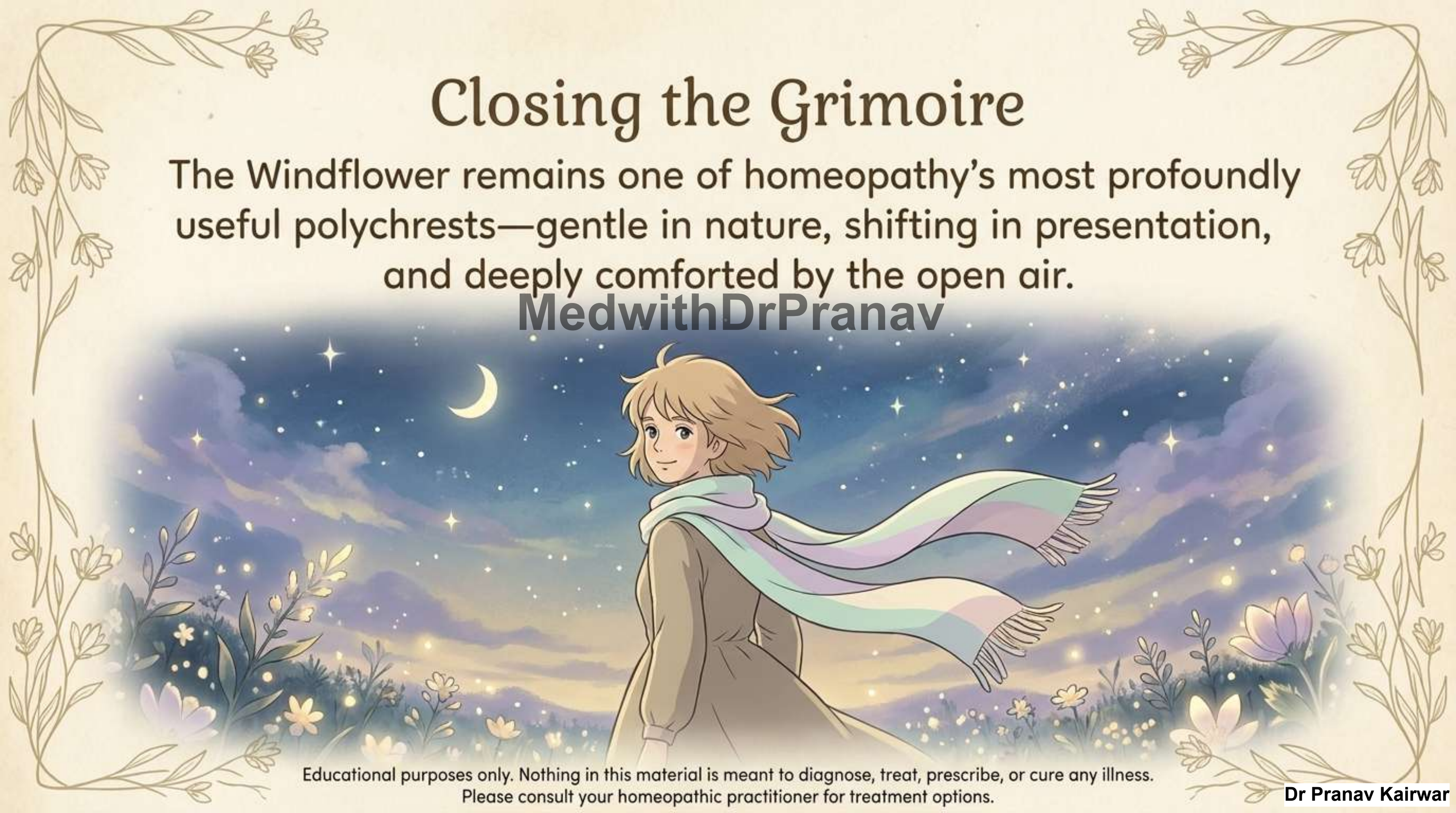
