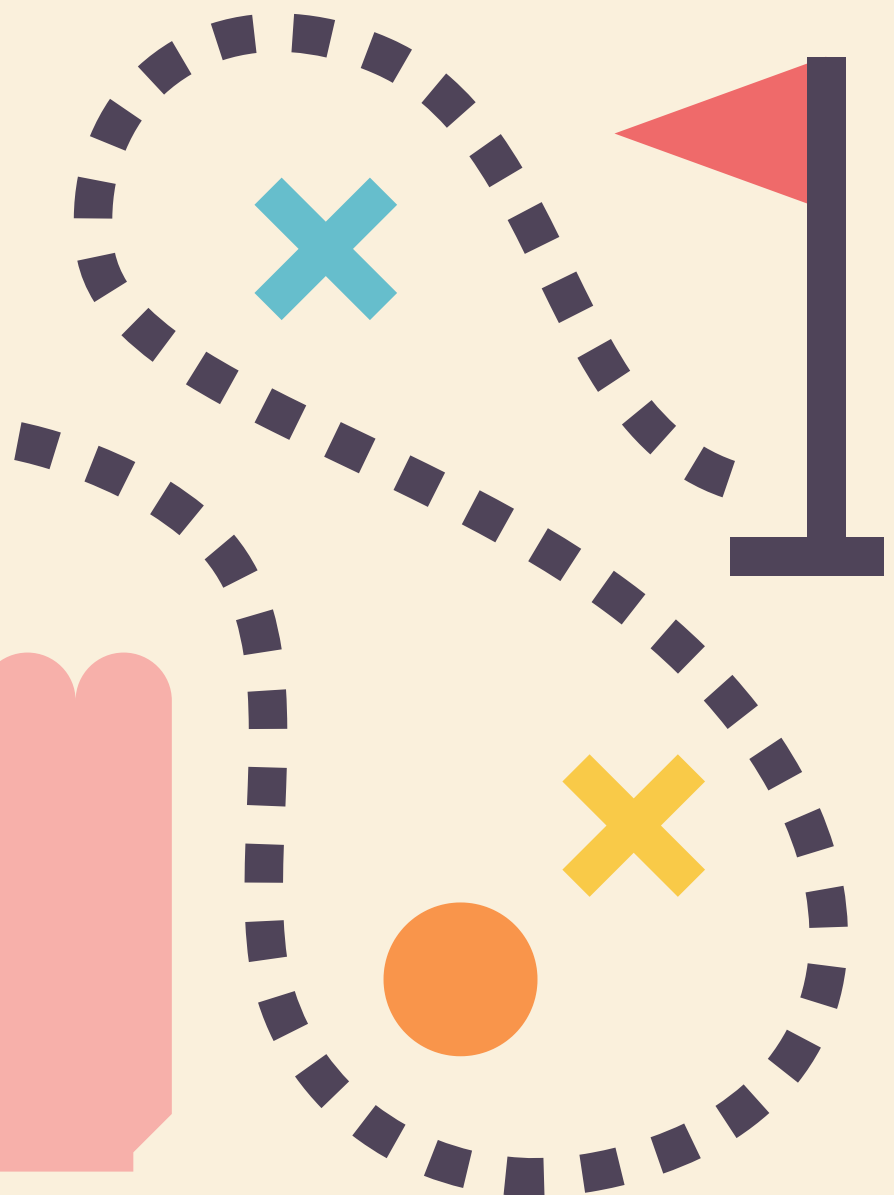
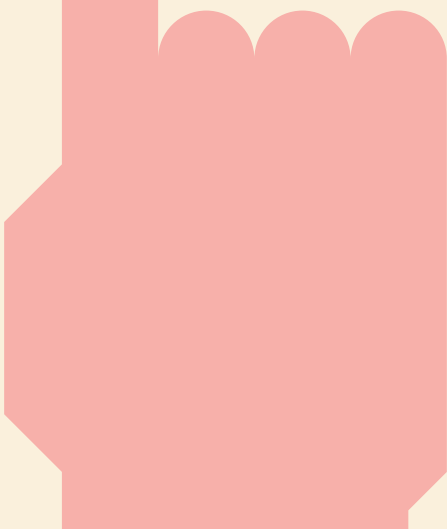
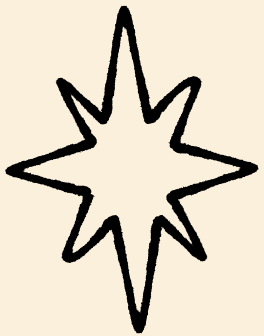

Principle 1



Assessment

Design assessment that provides meaningful data for Understanding.

- How am I checking if my students are learning?
- Do I design assessments that show understanding, not just recall?

My Reflection:

- Am I assessing for learning, or just recall?

Principle 2

Analysis



Interpreting the results to identify the cause of strengths and shortcomings.

- How do I interpret the results quickly and meaningfully?
- Am I looking for patterns, misconceptions and learning gaps?

- Am I looking for patterns, gaps and misconcepts or just scores?

Principle 3



Action

where the impact happens based on assessment evidence.

- What do I change in my teaching based on this evidence?
- Do I reteach, differentiate, or adapt strategies the right way?

- How quickly do I change my teaching based on assessment evidence?

Principle 4



Culture

Developing an environment that turns assessment into a growth mindset

- Is assessment in my classroom about growth or just grades?
- Do students see assessments as a tool to help them improve?
- Am I building trust where feedback leads to progress?

- Do my students see assessment as judgment - or a tool for progress?

Spot the Mistakes

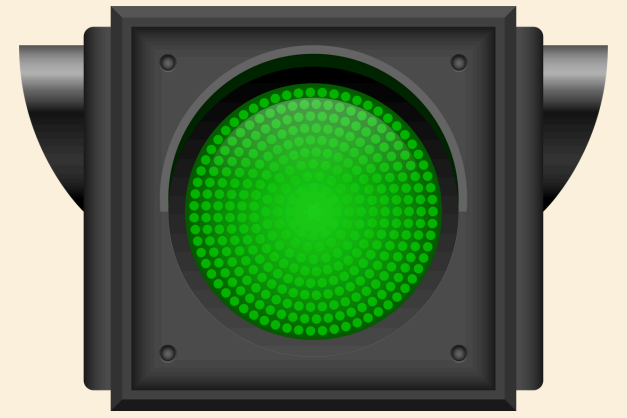


- I use assessment mainly for reporting, not guiding.
- Feedback comes too late to make a difference.
- I analyse results but don't change teaching.
- Students often lack the ability to effectively act on data.
- I design assessments too frequently.

Reset with Principles



- I use Assessments to diagnose Learning needs.
- I act on results quickly.
- I plan time for re-teaching based on assessment data/evidence.
- I involve students in reflecting on their own progress.
