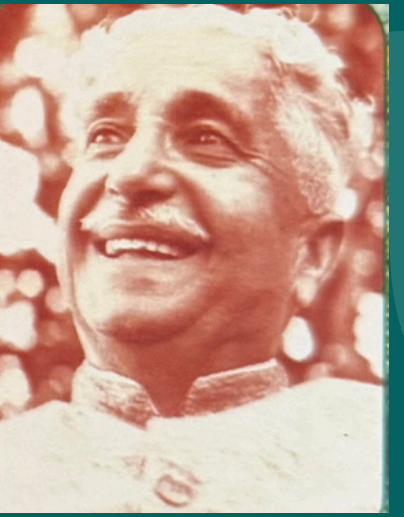

Keeping in view of the present health scenario in India in terms of health indices and statistics, as part of social commitment, our organization started “CHIPS – Child Health Improvement Program Service” in 2003 under the leadership of Sri M. R. Seetharam, Philanthropist & Vice Chairman, Gokula Education Foundation, Bangalore.

The main objective of our unit is to cater for rural children who need basic health care like nutrition, growth monitoring, treatment of acute and chronic infections, routine hearing and ophthalmology examination, behavioral assessment and scholastic backwardness, addressing adolescent issues like sexuality, smoking, drug abuse, child abuse and neglect, etc.

Since its inception about 3000 children have been medically examined every year. The statistical records of all these activities have been prepared according to the guidelines and followed accordingly. Besides routine health camps, regular follow-up and referral services were done.

Each program is therefore planned for scalability, sustainability, feasibility with available resources and funds. Presently resources have been procured only from the active members of the organization and resources from outside sources are utilized as supportive measures.

The success of all these activities was possible because of association with other organizations and personnel like Dr. Rajaram, Mr. Gundu Rao, Sri Ramana Free Clinic Trust, Bangalore; Dr. Prasanna Kumar - Bangalore Diabetic Hospital; Mr. & Mrs. Bharath - Dada Amar Trust; Mrs. Asha Wadwa & Mr. Sanjay Wadwa - Dada Vaswani Mission. 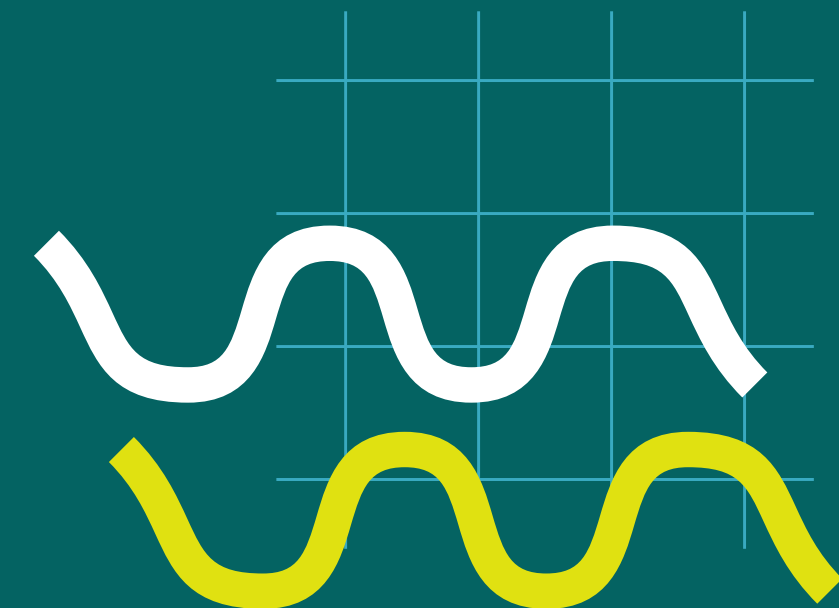

About the work we do...

Today's children are tomorrow's youth and future responsible citizens of our country. The progress of any nation depends on its resources. In this context, human resource is a major asset to our country. So we believe that taking care of children and providing them with the right ingredients to grow and flourish is the social responsibility of every citizen.

We, at Aniketana foundation, are a group of likeminded people, committed to serve the underprivileged children, with particular attention to rural population. We selected 'Health' as our focus of activity, which is often neglected especially in rural areas. In this regard, we targeted school children and mainly covered rural areas of Bangalore and Tumkur. In our school camps, we found that nutritional problems and dental problems due to poor hygiene were the major morbidity factors in children. 12% of the screened children were anemic, 14% were underweight. Poor dental hygiene was found in 60% of screened children and 32% had dental caries. Refractory errors like short-sightedness, long-sightedness, astigmatism were also detected in many children and corrected with spectacles. Respiratory problems like asthma were also detected and treated with inhaler therapy. We also conducted health camp for the urban poor and orphanage children in Bangalore like Sharanya children home, R.T.nagar and Annapoorni sevashram, Mathikere.

The other aspect of child's growth and development apart from health is a 'healthful environment'. We tried to address the issue as well by extending our support to procure resources like computers, books, blankets, beds, uniform etc. to the needy children.

The work done till now is just a beginning and we still are a long way away to achieve our goals. At this point, I would like to thank all our members and associate NGOs and pharmaceutical companies for their support.

Last but not the least; I would like to thank god almighty for giving us the strength and entrusting upon us this noble responsibility. I pray to him for his continued blessing and to help us to keep our spirits and commitments as our name suggests "Anikethana" - endless and unbound.

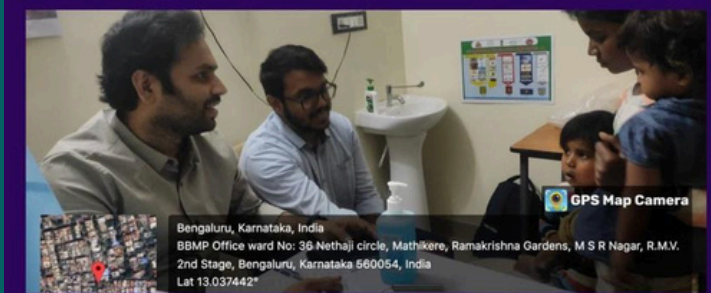
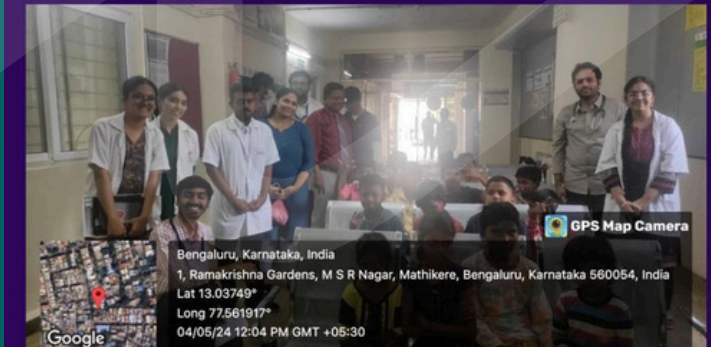
SCHOOL HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAMME

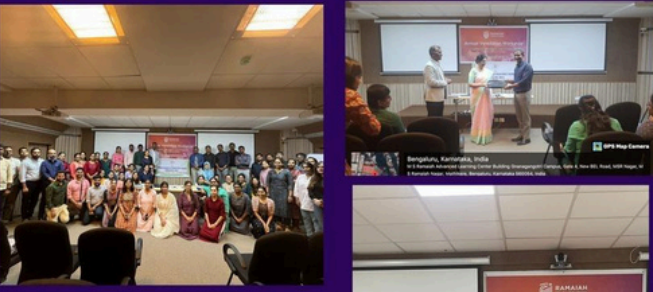
