WHY TBS

What Sets TBS Apart

Clients work with TBS because one in-country team covers the whole operation. Security, secure logistics, risk advisory, market entry, liaison and project support run through the same people on the ground in Libya, planned to the standards international organisations expect and reported clearly enough to act on. That matters most where work crosses several services at once, a visit that needs movement, security and local introductions in the same week, and the client only ever deals with one team holding it together.

TBS sizes each task to the activity and the level of risk, and scales from a single movement or visit to a longer programme. A client can start with one job, see how TBS works, and build from there without changing provider. Because the team is Libyan and permanently in-country, that support stays consistent as the work grows, with the same people and the same local knowledge behind it.

Clients keep a direct point of contact who is responsible for delivery. The points below set out what that means in practice.

Local presence

TBS knows the ground and works to the planning, communication and reporting standards international organisations expect.

One partner

Security, mobility, advisory, market entry, liaison and project support run through a single in-country team.

Built for decisions

Plans and reports stay clear, current and usable, so managers can act on them.

Proportionate

TBS sizes support to the task and the level of risk, so security fits the operation.

Scalable

TBS scales from a single movement or visit to a longer operational programme.

Accountable

Clients deal with a direct point of contact who is responsible for delivery.

Local knowledge, applied to the client's activity, and reported clearly enough to act on.

OUR PROCESS

How We Work

TBS applies the same four-step approach to every task and scales it to the size of the activity. Each step is confirmed with the client before the next begins.

01 Understand

TBS starts with the client's activity, locations, schedule, profile and exposure, and the decisions they need to make. This sets the scope of support and the level of risk to plan for.

01 Plan

TBS builds a plan around the client's schedule, covering people, vehicles, movement, communications and contingencies. The plan is confirmed with the client before any activity begins.

01 Deliver

TBS coordinates delivery through selected personnel, clear procedures and steady communication, and adjusts as conditions, schedules or requirements change on the ground.

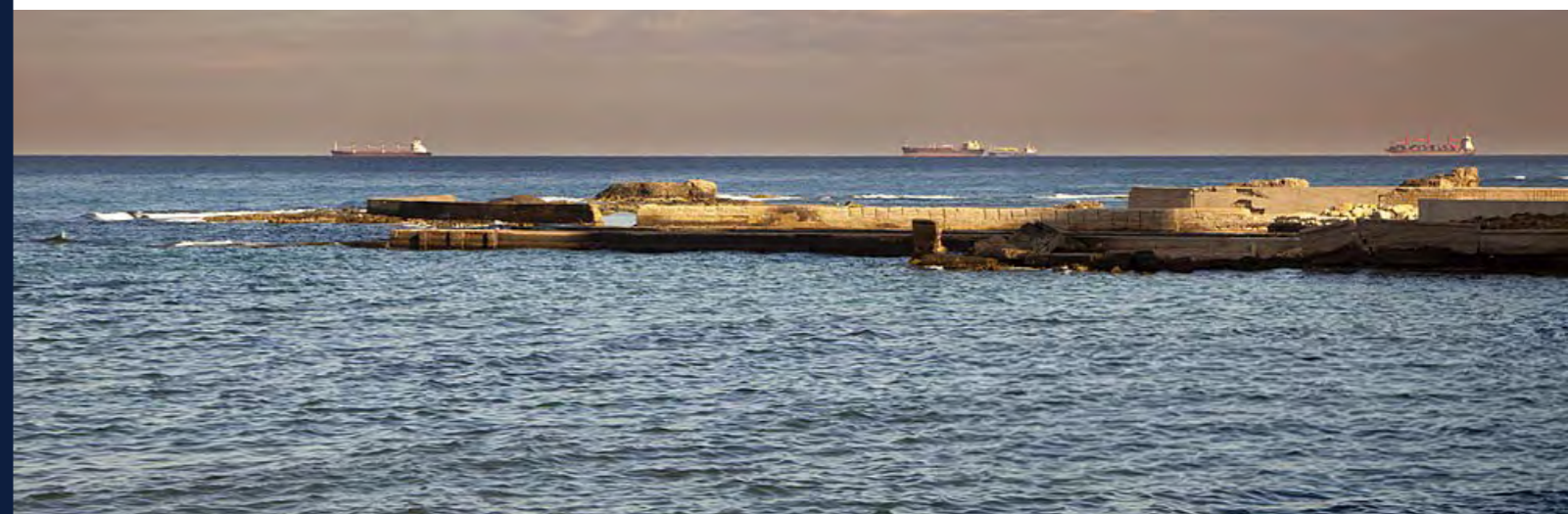
01 Report

TBS reports clearly and on time, in a form the client can act on. Reporting steps up when conditions change or an incident occurs, and closes with a short summary the client can use.

WHAT YOU RECEIVE

- An operating plan, confirmed before activity begins.
- A pre-movement or pre-entry briefing for the team.
- Daily coordination and updates while activity is live.
- Prompt incident reporting and escalation when needed.
- A short written summary at the close of the task.

One approach, applied to every task and scaled to its size, from a single movement to a longer programme.



HOW WE OPERATE

Standards and Approach

TBS works to the standards international organisations expect, and applies them to the everyday detail of an operation. Every task is planned on its own, with route, timing, contingencies and communications agreed before anyone moves. Duty of care runs through that planning: TBS protects people and assets and keeps the client informed as things develop. Reporting is written for the decision in hand, and clients always have a named point of contact, with the people who make commitments seeing them through. TBS works professionally and within local law, and the points below show how the standard holds on the ground.

Planning

Every task is planned individually, with route, timing, contingency and communication confirmed before activity.

Duty of care

TBS plans for the safety of personnel and the protection of assets, and keeps clients informed throughout.

Communication

Reporting is clear, timely and written for the decision that needs to be made.

Accountability

A direct point of contact, with the people who make commitments delivering them.

Conduct

Professional and proportionate, with respect for local law, communities and client confidentiality.

The standard

Applied to how TBS plans, communicates and reports, on every task.

ASSURANCE TO CLIENTS

Clients get a clear point of contact, regular reporting, and a record of what was planned, what changed and what was done.
