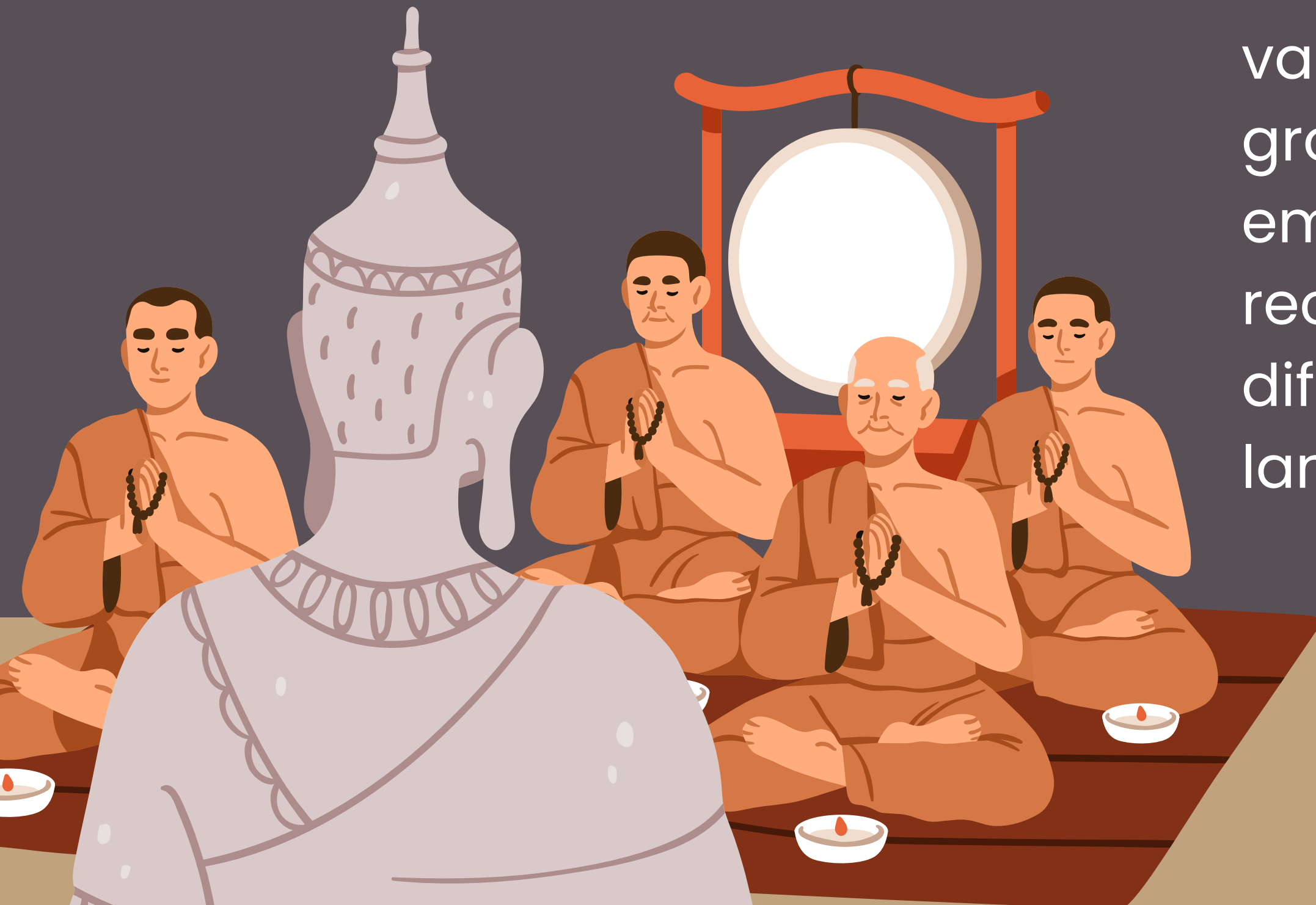






# Definition:
