

Universe Speaks Mini Oracle Deck

DIY Print & Cut Guide (Fronts & Backs) — 3.5" × 5" Cards

What you need

- Printer (inkjet or laser)
 - Heavy cardstock: **100 lb cover** (≈270 gsm) ideal; **80–100 lb cover** (≈216–270 gsm) also good
 - Paper trimmer or craft knife + metal ruler + cutting mat
 - **OR** sharp long-blade scissors (8"+) if you prefer scissors
 - Optional: **1/8" corner-rounder**; **3 mil laminating pouches**
 - Files included: **FRONT PDF** and **BACK PDF (card backs)**
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Quick Start (do this → tell me what you see → next)

1. Open the **FRONT PDF** (and the **BACK PDF** if you'll print backs).
 2. **Scale = 100% / Actual Size.**
→ You should see a normal page preview; **do not** use "Fit to page."
 3. **Paper size = US Letter (8.5" × 11").**
→ The preview should show about **0.5" margins** on all sides.
 4. **Quality = High/Best**; turn **OFF** Economy/Grayscale.
→ Colors should look rich in the preview.
 5. If your printer supports duplex: **Duplex ON** → **Flip on long edge** (portrait pages).
→ The dialog should show **2-sided printing**.
 6. Print **ONE** test sheet (front + back if duplex).
→ Hold it to the light: fronts and backs should line up top-to-top.
→ If upside-down, try **Flip on short edge** or rotate the **BACK PDF** 180° and test again.
 7. When the test looks good, print the full set.
 8. **No duplex?** See **Manual back printing (no duplex)** below.
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How the sheet is laid out (3.5" × 5" edition)

- Each sheet = 2 × 2 grid → 4 cards
- Card size = 3.5" × 5" (portrait)
- Printable area = 7.5" × 10" (because of 0.5" margins on US Letter)
- Horizontal gutter (between the two columns) = 1/8" (0.125") → safe cutting channel
- Vertical gutter (between the two rows) = 0" to keep exact 5" height within the 10" printable area
 - The **horizontal midline** is an exact shared cut—follow crop marks precisely.
 - If your template shows a faint vertical gap, follow the **printed crop marks** over any stated gutter.

Tip: Because vertical gutter = 0", take your time on that one long **center cut** so both rows remain exactly 5" tall.

Back side printing (duplex printers)

1. Open **FRONT PDF** → **Duplex ON** → **Flip on long edge** → print **ONE** test page.
 2. Open **BACK PDF** → **Scale 100%** → print the **matching** back page.
 3. Check alignment by holding the sheet to the light.
 4. If upside-down or shifted:
 - Try switching **long edge** ↔ **short edge**; or
 - Rotate **BACK PDF 180°** and test again.
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Manual back printing (no duplex)

1. Draw a small arrow on a blank test sheet pointing **into** the printer (feed direction).
 2. Print **Page 1** of the **FRONT PDF** on that sheet.
 3. Note where the arrow ended up (top/bottom; face up/down). That tells you how to reinsert.
 4. Reinsert your printed FRONT sheet(s) so the **BACK** prints on the reverse. Keep **Scale = 100%**.
 5. Print the **matching BACK** page. Hold to light to check alignment.
 - Upside-down? Rotate the **BACK PDF 180°** and reprint a test.
 - Mirrored side-to-side? Flip the stack the other way and test again.
 6. When the test aligns, print the rest in small batches.
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Cutting

TRIMMER / KNIFE METHOD

- Cut straight down the **center of the 1/8" horizontal gutters** (between columns).
- Make the **long horizontal midline cut** (between rows) exactly on the crop marks—this is a **shared edge** (0" gutter).
- Long cuts first, then finish the shorter ones.

SCISSORS METHOD

- Use sharp, long-blade scissors (8"+).
- First slice the sheet into **two columns** along the 1/8" vertical gutters; then separate **top and bottom** rows on the midline; then trim individual cards.
- Aim **exactly** on the midline cut between rows so both cards remain 5" tall.
- Make long, smooth strokes; rotate the paper rather than your wrist.
- If straight cuts are tricky, lightly score a guide with a ruler and blunt tip, or draw a faint pencil line to follow.

CORNERS

- Corner-round with a **1/8" rounder** for a pro look, or make two tiny curved snips per corner with scissors.
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Optional lamination

- **3 mil** pouches keep cards flexible for shuffling (even at 3.5" × 5").
 - **Laminate first, then cut** and re-round corners.
 - Leave a thin sealed edge (~1–2 mm) around each card so the pouch stays closed.
 - If laminating, **80–100 lb cover** often feels best afterward.
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Troubleshooting

- **Backs slightly off:** try the other Flip option (**short vs long edge**) or rotate **BACK PDF 180°**; always test one sheet first.
 - **Vertical shift only:** some printers have a duplex registration offset; look for a “Registration/Alignment” setting and nudge by **±0.5–1.0 mm** if available.
 - **Colors dull:** set **Quality = High/Best**; turn **OFF** Economy/Grayscale.
 - **Rough edges:** new blade, rotary trimmer, or sharper scissors helps a lot.
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Care & sacred use

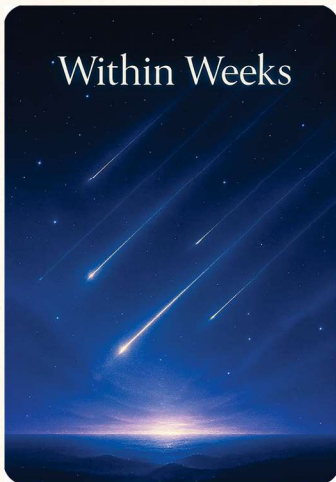
- Store in a pouch or small box.
 - Before first use, hold the deck to your heart and say:
“**May these cards speak clearly and kindly for the highest good.**”
 - To refresh between readings: tap the deck, fan in moonlight, or rest on selenite.

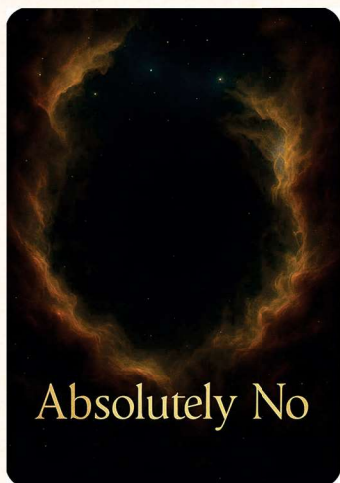

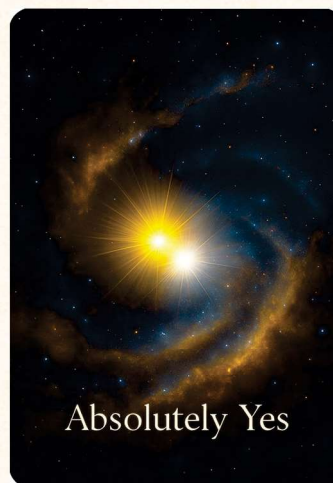

Better than Imagined

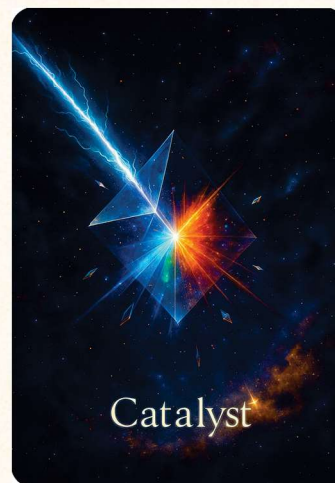
Answer: Yes — exceeds expectations.

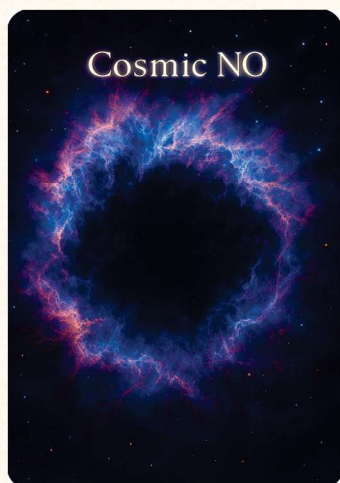
Answer: Change is activated.
