

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

1. **NAME OF SOCIETY:** -The name of Society shall be, "INTELLECTUALS & JURISTS MUSLIM ASSOCIATION (IJMA)".
2. **REGISTERED OFFICE:** - The Registered Office of The Association would be located at Chamber No.61, Civil Side, (Ground Floor), Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi-110054.
3. **WORKING AREA:** - The working area of the Association would be Delhi and ~~NCR~~.
4. **AIMS AND OBJECTS:** -

The aims and objects of society for which the same is established are as under: -

The main object of the Association is to fight for rights and justice social, economic political and religious for minorities and other marginalized sections of society and to raise their voice against atrocities and intolerable discrimination on the basis of cast, region and religion through the peaceful means and constitutional methods. Further aims and objects are as under: -

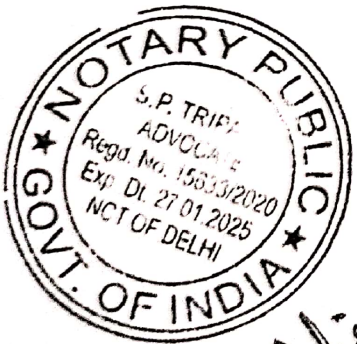
- a) To prevent exploitation of Minorities and other marginalized sections through Constitutional methods.
- b) To strive and work for communal harmony with a view to preventing communal violence.
- c) To make efforts to resolve the disputes amongst individuals, communities and groups of people by way of dialogue in the spirit of Quran and Hadith, Indian constitution and human rights charter in consultation with qualified Muftis, Alims, Hafiz, Islamic scholars, advocates, jurists, eminent journalists and scholars of other religion.
- d) To render legal assistance to the victims (belonging to Minorities and other marginalized sections of society) who have been falsely implicated by any government/nongovernmental agencies, any party, group or society and have no proper sources of income to fight their cases in the courts.



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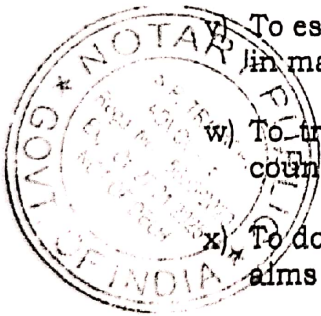
- c) To work for social, cultural, economic, educational and political developments of Minorities and other marginalized sections of society.
- f) To represent minorities and other marginalized sections of society before any authority, like Central Government, State Government, autonomous bodies especially regarding any matter affecting their religious, cultural, social, political or legal rights and interests.
- g) To work in co-operation with any other association or group of persons whose aims and objects are similar to those of the Association.
- h) To promote unity, brotherhood and co-operation amongst members related to legal profession.
- i) To make efforts to create more job opportunities for newly joined Lawyers, advocates and give them practical training by organizing various training programs and to encourage young people to take legal profession as service to the community at large.
- j) To make and prepare a team of Advocates and other related people at District, State and National Level to take the matters to court wherever and whenever injustice is being done to any person, group of persons or any entity belonging to Minorities and other marginalized sections of society.
- k) To mobilize the people, group of people, pressure groups, NGOs etc to put the pressure on government agencies to take proper and timely action against the criminals, anti-social elements and religious groups or other organizations spreading hatred vitiating the atmosphere and endangering the life, liberty and property of any person.
- l) To preserve, maintain and safeguard the prestige, dignity, status, rights and privileges of legal professionals.
- m) To conduct seminars, conferences, debates and moot courts, in respect of Legal Studies.
- n) To start coaching classes/camps for candidates appearing for LLB., Judicial Services Examinations, UPSC, PCS and other competitive examinations.



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- o) To make efforts to open Law Colleges and to promote legal profession as career of youngsters.
- p) To make efforts to open Mediation Centers with proper permission and recognition of the Government specially to deal with family and civil disputes of minorities and other backward sections of society.
- q) To arrange to give free legal aid to those in need and also to act as the service providers to start shelter home, family counselling for education, legal counselling for family, matrimonial, property and other civil disputes.
- r) To endeavor to protect the Waqf properties by creating strong Waqf Property Protecting Wing consisting of Advocates and other related persons at all possible levels in lawful manner.
- s) To render services to the courts in respect of matters related to Muslim Personal Law and to get Muslim personal law codified within the framework of the constitution of India.
- t) To establish self-help groups and to create an emergency relief fund for the minorities.
- u) To make efforts to start a channel and newspaper at state and national levels.
- v) To establish schools, Colleges, University and to bring reforms in madarsa education system.
- w) To train maulvi/Islamic scholar, advocate, social worker as counsellor/mediators for resolving the disputes in the parties.
- x) To do all other things conducive to the attainment of the above aims and objects.
- y) The Society shall invest its money and funds according to the section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- z) To do all acts/things/activities which are necessary and may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the objects of the society.
- za) All the activities shall be non-profitable and shall be done on No Profit No Loss basis.





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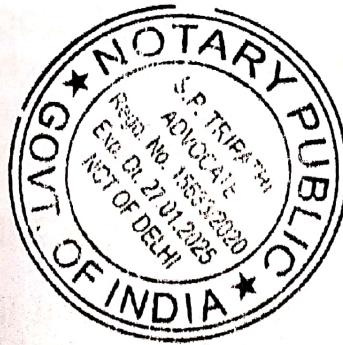
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z) All the incomes, earning, moveable or immovable properties of the society shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only as set forth in the Memorandum of the Society and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or any manner whatsoever to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members. No member no member of society shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the society or make any profits whatsoever, by virtue of this membership.

1. NAME OF SOCIETY: - The name of Society shall be "INTELLECTUALS & JURISTS MUSLIM ASSOCIATION(IJMA)".

2. REGISTERED OFFICE OF THE ASSOCIATION: -

The Registered office of the Association shall be located at such place/places as the Governing Body may decide from time to time. However, at present the office of the Association shall be located at Chamber No.61, Civil Side, (Ground Floor), Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi-110054.

3. MEMBERSHIP: -

The general membership of the society is open to any person who is a Muslim Advocate/lawyer, jurists, social activist, Mufti, Fazil, Alim, Hafiz, Islamic scholar, eminent journalsit having special and extra-ordinary knowledge of sharia laws, hadith, Muslim Personal Laws and jurisprudence. The membership may also be granted to any other pers on subject to the approval of Governing Bodies in exceptional cases. The members of Governing Body shall be elected through elections to be held in General Body meeting.

i) HONORARY MEMBERS: -

The Governing Body shall have the right to appoint 5 distinguished/eminent persons as **HONRARY MEMBERS** who shall not pay any admission fee. These members shall not be allowed to cast their vote.

ii) PATRON OF THE ASSOCIATION: -

The Governing Body shall have the right to appoint distinguished/eminent persons as **PATRON(S)** of Society/Association from to time.

iii) PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE: -

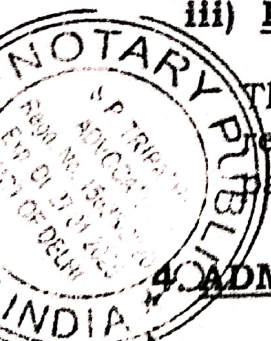
The Governing Body shall have right to appoint a Permanent representative (s) of the Association who shall be distinguished in any particular field.

4. ADMISSION FEE AND SUBSCRIPTION: -

The admission Fee and subscription shall be as under unless otherwise revised by the Governing Body.

a) Admission Fee for all the members shall be Rs.500/-.

b) In addition to this, all the members shall have to pay a month ly subscription @ Rs.50/- (Rs.600/- per annum).



5. TERMINATION OR CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP: -

The Governing Body of the Society shall have the power to expel/terminate a member(s) from the membership of the above society/association on the following grounds: -

- i) Death.
- ii) Resignation.
- iii) If found to be involved in any anti-social/criminal activities
- iv) If adjudged by any court of law as criminal/offender or of unsound mind.
- v) If found guilty by means of anti-propaganda of Aims and Objects of Society.
- vi) If does not pay prescribed annual fee for a period of one year.

6. RE-ADMISSION: -

In case membership of any person is terminated by the Governing body for not paying one-year subscription/fee, such member can be re-admitted after all dues are paid by him with the permission of the Governing Body.

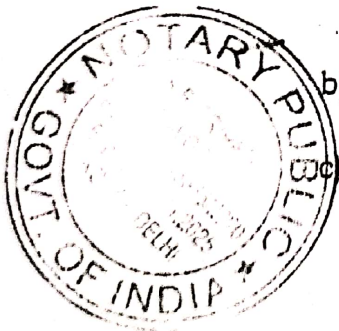
7. GENERAL BODY: -

All the members will constitute the General Body.

a) **NOTICE:** - Minimum 15 days' notice shall be given to the members before the General Body Meeting, enclosing agenda of meeting, specifying date, time, place and brief of issues to be discussed in the meeting.

b) **MEETING:** - General Body meeting shall be held once a year regularly in the month of April/May.

QUORUM: - Quorum of General Body shall be 2/3 of the total strength of General Body Members of society. In case complete quorum is not available, proceedings of the meeting shall be adjourned for half an hour and after half an hour when meeting resumes the quorum shall be same i.e. 2/3 of members present and voting.



8. GOVERNING BODY:-

The Governing Body shall consist of 21 members out these 10 members will be post holders 11 members will be called as executive members. These members will be elected through election for a period of three years.

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- i) **STRENGTH:** - The Governing Body shall comprise of 21 members in all.
- ii) **QUORUM:** - Would be 2/3 of total strength (including office bearers and executive members)
- iii) **TERM:** - The term of Governing Body shall be for three years.
- iv) **NOTICE:** - Minimum 7 days' Notice shall be required to Governing Body Meeting but urgent meeting of Governing Body can be called by 24 hours' notice.
- v) **MEETING:** - Meeting of Governing Body shall be held as and when it decides to call.
- v) **URGENT MEETING:** - May be called by the 24-hour notice and Quorum would be 2/3 of strength of Governing Body.

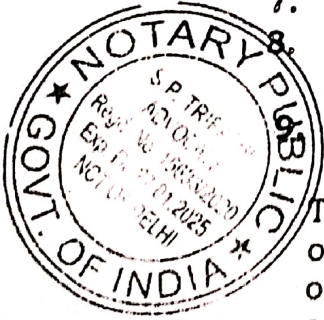

FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF GOVERNING BODY: -

The Governing Body shall be responsible for the management of all affairs of Society and also be authorized to appoint any office bearer/executive member to manage a particular activity. Governing Body shall also have the power to take necessary steps for the implementation of all the programs and policies drawn by the Governing Body. Further powers and functions shall be as under: -

- a) To pass necessary expenditure to meet the day today's requirements of the Society/Association.
- b) To take decisions on applications for new membership.
- c) To prepare plans, projects and programs.



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- d) To manage affairs of Society/Association and to keep control over the property and all its assets.
- e) To invest funds of society/Association in such a manner may be determined by the Governing Body in accordance with law.
- f) To send representatives to represent the Society/Association in any Organization, Department, NGOs, NPOs etc for the purpose of business/training/or to attend any function to promote/propagate the interests and enhancement of the income of the Society in lawful manner.
- g) To appoint Returning Officer for holding Election with the consent of the members (other than Governing Body) of Society.
- h) To arrange and receive finance, loan from any bank, organization, legal entity or individual(s) on reasonable terms and conditions through lawful and constitutional means .
- i) To accept donations, grants, gifts, contributions, subscriptions and endowments in lawful manner.
- j) To establish, collect and manage funds through various sources for short- and long-term objects of Society and for welfare of legal and religious fraternity in particular and community at large.
- k) To receive money, securities, instruments, movable or immovable property for and on behalf of society in lawful manner.
- l) To enter into agreement with other similar entities for and on behalf of Society in lawful manner.
- m) To take any other legal step for smooth functioning and better management of Society.
- n) To prepare budget estimates of the Association for each year and to sanction expenditure within the limits of the budget.
- o) To meet annually to consider and pass such resolutions and the annual report, annual accounts and financial estimates of the Association.
- p) To make rules and guidelines for smooth, unbiased and fair elections and shall have the power to prescribe, fix, reduce or increase the amount of fee for contesting election for various posts of Governing Body.

10. POWERS AND DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS: -

The Powers and duties of office bearers and executive members shall be as under: -

1) PRESIDENT: -

- a) President shall have powers to control, supervise and issue general directions for smooth management of the affairs

relating to the Society. The President shall also enjoy the powers as detailed below.

- b) All the meetings of Governing Body and General Body of the Association shall be presided over by the President.
- c) President shall have the power to summon/call any emergent/urgent meeting of Governing Body and General Body by giving a short notice.
- d) President shall have the power to allow any subject Matter in the agenda for discussion in course of proceedings/meetings.
- e) President shall have the power to cast an extra vote to decide any matter in case tie.
- f) In the course of proceedings/meetings of the Governing Body or the General Body, the decision of the President shall be considered as final (in case of dispute as to the meaning or interpretation of any Rule etc.).
- g) In case it is necessary to decide any point/matter/issue urgently and there is no time to the Governing Body Meeting, the President have the powers to decide the/issue but he shall bring the matter to the notice of the Governing Body as early as possible.

ii) SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT: -

There shall be one Senior Vice President to assist the President in his work. Senior Vice President shall enjoy all powers of President in his absence. In the event of President resigning from the post or post falls vacant, the Senior Vice President or one of the Vice President (in the absence of Senior Vice President) shall act as President till the regular president is elected/appointed.

iii) VICE PRESIDENT: -

There shall be two Vice Presidents to assist the Senior Vice President in his work. Vice President(s) shall enjoy all powers of Senior Vice President in his absence. In the absence of President and Sr. Vice President either of two Vice Presidents shall act as President. In event of Senior Vice President resigning from the post or the post falls vacant the one of the Vice President shall act as Senior Vice President till regular Senior Vice President is elected/appointed.



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iv) GENERAL SECRETARY: -

- a) General Secretary shall have the power to summon/call any emergent/urgent meeting of Governing Body and General Body by giving a short notice
- b) General Secretary shall sign all the notices, circulars and other letters relating to the correspondence of the Association.
- c) General Secretary will circulate all the meeting notices or other notices to the concerned office Bearers and Executive members.
- d) General Secretary will prepare all registers pertaining to the working, expenditure, budget, various other welfare schemes and maintain records of the accounts of the Society and will supervise all the work of Society.
- e) He will also bring into the notice of President all things which are necessary (beneficiary and detrimental) to the interest of society. He will advise the President on all important and relevant matters and issues as and when it is necessary and is asked for by the President.



The General Secretary shall have the power to appoint or recruit anybody for the proper efficient discharge subject to the approval of the Governing body

JOINT SECRETARY: -

There shall be Two Joint Secretaries to assist General Secretary. They shall enjoy all the powers of General Secretary in his absence.

TREASURER: -

- a) All the funds of Society shall remain under care and management of Treasurer of Association. He shall maintain the accounts of the Association and shall be the custodian of funds, the Bank Pass Book and Cheque Books and other related accounts books and reports.
- b) He shall keep the President and the General Secretary updated with financial position of the Association and

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shall furnish all information relating to the accounts as and when the same is asked for.

c) Treasurer shall produce all Books of Accounts before the Governing Body in its meetings as and when required or asked for.

d) He shall make funds available for all expenditure.

e) He shall keep the amount/funds in the Nationalized/ reputed Co-operative Bank under the advice of the President and General Secretary.

He shall get the accounts of the Association audited by a reputed Chartered Accountant.

f) He shall make transactions exceeding Rs. 5,000/- by cheque countersigned by General Secretary/President as the case may be.

g) he shall have an imprest amount of Rs.10,000/- in cash to meet daily petty expenses.

vii) **ASSISTANT TREASURER: -**

There will two Assistant Treasurers to help and assist the treasurer. In the absence of the Treasurer the entire work of the accounts shall be looked after by the Assistant Treasurers and they will enjoy all powers of Treasurer.

viii) **EXECUTIVE MEMBERS: -**

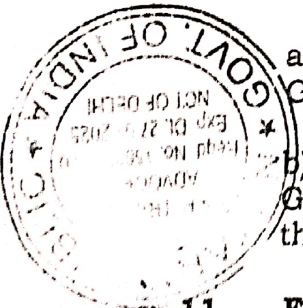
In addition to the post holders there shall be 11 executive members in the Governing Body.

a) Executive Member is an important part of Governing Body.

b) Executive Member is also supposed to attend all the Governing Body meetings and the General Body Meetings of the Association.

11. **ELECTION: -**

The General Body in its Annual Meeting shall Elect Office bearers and the Executive Members of Governing Body after every three years by secret ballot papers system or by show of hands. The Governing Body shall appoint a Returning Officer to conduct fair, smooth and unbiased election of members of Governing Body. For this purpose, guidelines



and rules shall be framed by the Governing Body. While making rules, the Governing Body shall also have power to prescribe fee for contesting candidates which may vary from time to time and shall be paid by them from the time of filing nomination.

12. DISPUTES: -

All the disputes with respect to the functioning of society and election shall be referred to a Tribunal consisting of three members to be appointed by the Governing Body and the decision of the Tribunal shall be final.

13. FILLING UP CASUAL VACANCIES: -

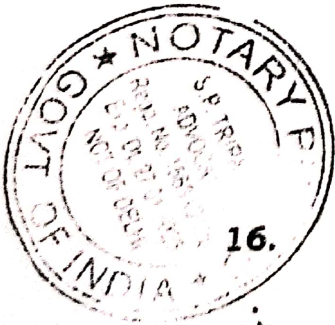
Any Casual vacancy, amongst office bearers and executive members of Governing Body shall be filled by the resolution passed by the Governing Body and such appointments shall be confirmed by the Governing Body in its coming meetings.

14. SUB-COMMITTEES: -

- a) The Governing Body may appoint Sub-Committees as and when it considers expedient to assist the Governing Body in the furtherance of achievements of the objects of Society and may dissolve any such committee.
- b) The Sub-Sub Committees may have such powers as may be delegated to them by the Governing Body.

15. ADVISORY BOARD: -

Governing Body shall be authorized to constitute an Advisory Board to solve any matter/issue and can nominate its members and Chairman to attain any particular object of the Association.



16. FINANACIAL YEAR: -

The financial year of the Association shall be from the 1st day of April to 31st of March, every year.

17. SOURCES OF INCOME: -

Income of the Association shall be utilized only for the attainment of aims and objects of Association. Sources of Income of Association shall be as under: -

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- a) Admission fee and subscriptions from members of Association.
- b) Donations and Special Contributions to be received in lawful manner.
- c) Fund generated through various general business, beneficiary schemes and other extra-curricular activities to be carried out by the Association to raise the income and to incur such generated income in achieving the goal of the Association.

18. **ACCOUNTS OPERATION: -**

Entire amount shall be kept in Nationalized bank / Cooperative Bank and account shall be operated by General Secretary and Treasurer or any other person authorized by the Governing Body.

19. **AUDIT: -**

Accounts of the Association would be audited by a qualified Chartered Accountant every year.

20. **ANNUAL LIST OF MEMBERS OF GOVERNING BODY:**

Annual Governing Body Members list shall be filed in the month of January in the office of Registrar of Societies in compliance with section 4 of Societies Registration Act of 1860, as applicable to National Capital Territory of Delhi.

21. **LEGAL PROCEEDINGS: -**

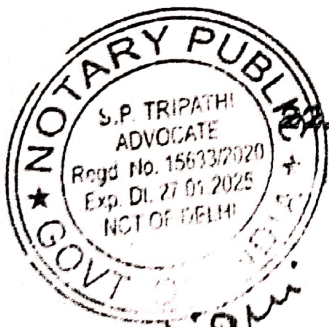
Association/Society may sue and /or be sued in the name of President as per provisions laid down in Section 6 of the Societies Registration Act of 1860 as applicable to National Capital Territory of Delhi.

AMENDMENT: -

Any amendment in Memorandum, Rules and Regulations shall be made in accordance with the Section 12 and 12-A of Society Registration Act of 1860.

23. **DISSOLUTION: -**

If required, the Association may be dissolved by way of passing a resolution in the meeting of General Body with 3/5th majority of votes. Under such circumstances, the accounts of the Association shall be



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settled. Surplus funds, assets and property of the Association shall be donated to other Association having similar objects. Procedure laid down under Section 13 and 14 of Societies Registration Act 1860 for dissolution of Association shall be followed.

24. **APPLICABILITY OF THE ACT: -**

All the provisions under all the sections of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, as applicable to the National Capital Territory of Delhi, shall apply to this society.
